USEF/USDF **2015** Tests will be used. Each dressage exhibitor may ride two dressage tests. Exhibitor may ride two different tests or a single test twice.

Dressage Seat Equitation is a state qualifying rail class which all exhibitors may enter; it includes work as a group in the dressage court, and the judge may also ask for a short pattern or additional work to decide placings.

For both Intermediates and Seniors,

T-3 is the state qualifying test for Training Level

1-3 is the state qualifying test for First Level

2-3 is the state qualifying test for Second level.

If exhibitor chooses to ride two state qualifying tests or the same state qualifying test twice, highest score will be used for state qualifying.

Things to consider as you decide which dressage tests to ride –

- At what dressage level (intro, training, first) are my horse and I currently performing? Generally, you should choose tests from that level.
- Am I interested in state qualifying and am I ready to ride a state qualifying test? If yes to both, choose at least one state qualifying test as specified above. You may choose to ride the state qualifying test twice.
- Would I prefer to ride one test two times or two different tests on the same day? A reader can be used at our county event but not at State Fair. If you use a reader you are not eligible for medals (if offered) or state fair.
