FOR NON 4-H DRESSAGE SHOWS AND STATE FAIR

You must complete all steps correctly to receive your medal

It is your responsibility to complete this form correctly or you are not eligible for the qualification or the medal. If you have a question,,,,ask. Read pg70 of the Medals Rule Book.

Allowing our members to earn a medal or qualify outside of 4-H shows is a privilege and if not done correctly we can't track it appropriately with our database. If it is a chronic problem we will not be able to offer this opportunity in the future.

A paper trail and documentation is important for the integrity of this program.

Here are the steps for QUALIFYING for the medals program in Dressage at a non-4-H show:

- 1. If you earn 60% or higher in Training Level Test 1 or above
- 2. Show is judged by an "L" carded judge
- 3. The current 2022 USEF Dressage test was ridden
- 4. You did not use a reader for your qualifying test
- 5. You have a horse certificate on file prior to April 1st of that 4-H year

If all of the above is correct then:

- 1. Fill out FORM #2 completely and correctly
- 2. Include a copy of your signed score sheet
- 3. Send FORM #2 to the Medals Chairperson (Lori Glasgow) within 5 days of the show

Here are the steps for **EARNING** a dressage medal at a non-4-H show:

- 1. The medals chair (Lori Glasgow) MUST receive all 3 of the following things at least 5 days prior to the show:
 - a. Your completely filled out FORM #1
 - b. \$15 (check made out to King County Horse 4-H)
 - c. Show premium listing show info

AND THEN AT THE SHOW:

- 1. You CAN NOT earn a dressage medal at the same show that you qualified at
- 2. Show is judged by an "L" carded judge
- 3. You did not use a reader for the test
- 4. The current 2022 USEF tests are being used
- 5. You can only earn the Bronze after qualifying, the Silver after the Bronze, the Gold after the Silver and the Supreme points after the Gold. You can not skip medals or earn 2 medals at 1 show for non 4-H shows, regardless what test you rode or what score you earned.
- 6. Scores required for medals:
 - a. Bronze earned with 63% in Training Level Test 2 or above
 - b. Silver earned with 63% in Training Level Test 3 or above
 - c. Gold earned with 63% in First Level Test 1 or above
 - d. 1 Supreme point earned with 63% on First Level Test 2 or First Level Freestyle If all of the above is correct, and you earned the required score, then:
- 1. Fill out FORM #2 completely and correctly
- 2. Send FORM #2 and a copy of your signed score sheet to the Medals Chair (Lori Glasgow) within 5 days of the show
- 3. The Medals Chair will get your medal to you the next time you or your leader attend a 4-H function
