# RECORD BOOK INSTRUCTIONS

Calendar - Enter all dates relevant to 4-H. Place a check after the events you attended.

Project Goals - Setting goals for yourself is a very important skill. This is an agreement between you, your parents and your leader about what you want to learn, how they can help you and your hopes for your club.

Horse Care - Hoof Care & Feed Records; Enter relevant information. Estimate if your family has more than one horse. Board & Barn Maintenance; Enter all board fees that you pay or supplies purchased for maintenance and improvements if you have your own barn. Miscellaneous Needs; This is for all those little items that don't seem to fall under any of the offered headings. Total at end of year.

Vet Records - Vaccinations; Enter all vaccinations that your project horse received during the 4-H year include cost. De-Worming; Enter all de-wormer that your horse received during the 4-H year, include brand and when next dose is due. Misc. Vet Care; For when your horse requires a vet visit other than routine, or not specified. Total at end of year.

Member Records - Current Inventory; Enter all substantial tack and attire that you had at the beginning of the year. Maintenance is for any improvements or repairs done to that piece during the year. Record the sale price if you sold the item during the year. Purchased Tack & Attire; For recording all tack and attire that you purchased during the current 4-H year, it's condition and if you had to make any changes to the item. Lessons & Training Log; This is for your lessons, off season training and to track the cost of these. Also include all clinics attended with your horse. If you don't receive lessons, record your private training sessions and leave the cost blank, lucky you. => Total at end of year.

Project Journal - This is your opportunity to record your special moments throughout the 4-H year. Your first medal, a goal achieved or a new one set. It's a way to keep track of those highs and lows in your year.

Exhibit Journal - This is for all shows and fairs, anytime you enter classes with your horse. Record the Date, who put on the show, the facility, horse you rode and the cost of the entire show in the left column then record the classes, placing and judge on each line.

Event Log - This is to record your achievements in competitions and events where you competed in 4-H without your horse.

Training Log - This is for you to track your riding, set a goal for the month, place a tally in the box for every hour you ride and at the end of the month count how you did.

Project Highlights - How did those goals work out? Did you run into any bumps along the way? How did you handle them, would you do anything differently? What were your successes?

Story - Write this in a narrative form as if you were talking to the reader. Use 4 parts, introduce yourself, write about your projects. Share your 4-H club experience and how you were involved in community and school. Finally write about how you have changed and grown as a result of your 4-H experience.

Community Service - Record your clubs community service activities and how they affected you.
